



NEEDLE & THREAD: FINISHING KNOT FOR ANY KIND OF HAND-STITCHING OR EMBROIDERY


To finish the thread at the end of stitching:

1. Pull the needle underneath the last stitch, without letting the needle go through the material. Don't pull the thread all the way through; leave a little loop.





2. Pull the needle through the little loop you left.







3. Pull the thread snugly to the project without stressing the stitching.





4. This is still a loose knot, so repeat this process once more to create a second knot over the first one.





5. After pulling the second knot snug, trim thread to $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
